Curriculum Updates:

Math (Mrs. H):

Monday: *MAP Testing Tuesday: *1.7 Equations Wednesday: *Review (Day 1) Thursday: *Review (Day 2)

Friday: *Ch. 1 Test

Math (Mrs. C): We will begin the last half of Chapter 3 next week dividing multi digit numbers and decimals. We will use class time on Monday to finish the Math portion of the MAPS test.

Math (Mr. W): Next week, we will continue chapter three: Compute With Multi-Digit

Numbers. The lessons are as follows:

Monday: 3.4 Multiply Decimals by Decimals Tuesday: 3.5 Divide Multi-Digit Numbers Wednesday: 3.6 Estimate Quotients

Thursday: 3.7 Divide Decimals by Whole Numbers

Friday: 3.8 Divide Decimals by Decimals

ELA: We have had a lot of fun reading stories and articles about names. Students should be sure they have finished the reflection questions from the *Names and Nombres* short story for Monday's class discussion. Next week, we will start writing a 5 paragraph essay about names. Most of this work will be done in class. For Book Clubs, students have an assignment due on Friday Sept 22nd that can be located in Google Classroom.

Social Studies: 6th Social Studies

In Chapter 1, students are learning about social scientists who investigate the past. The "Essential Question" that we will be asking is: *How do social scientists interpret the past?* In the course of reading this lesson and participating in the classroom activity, students will

Social Studies

- explain how social scientists such as archaeologists, historians, and geographers investigate the past.
- hypothesize about the lives of prehistoric humans and compare ideas with those of social scientists.
- interpret a cave painting by using the methodology of social scientists.

Language Arts

- clarify an understanding of texts by creating logical notes.
- write expository compositions that offer persuasive evidence to validate arguments and conclusions.

Science: Students have made multisensory observations of sealed black boxes in an effort to determine what is inside. Students worked in small groups to develop conceptual and physical models of the same black box. Students used these models to explain what was in their black boxes. The class will take a short quiz based on these experiences and notes they have taken next Tuesday (9/19).

Religion: We will focus our discussion on Sacred Scripture. 6th graders will start memorizing the books of the Old Testament. They will be able to organize the Old Testament books into sections: Pentateuch, Historical Book, Prophetic Books and the Wisdom Books.
